Green Friendly Policies

Hotels and Restaurants

1. Paper products are recycled in all departments.
2. Landscaping refuse is recycled
3. Bottles are recycled in all departments
4. Aluminum products are recycled.
5. Air filters on all A/Cs in the guestrooms and public areas are replaced consistently.
6. Office A/C units, Computers and lights are turned off every evening.
7. All housekeeping linen closets have automatic light turnoff when not in use.
8. Housekeeping staff turn off A/C units and lights in all unoccupied rooms.
9. Participate in "Good Earth keeping - Conserve for tomorrow" program - tent card in all guest rooms with instructions for not having linens and/or bath towels laundered.
10. 1" insulated glad windows in guest rooms and public areas to cut back on all energy usage
11. Drapes are closed to 12"
12. All hotel staff encouraged to bring own reusable Nalgene water bottles and/or coffee cups for daily use.
13. Use new water filtration using city water and reverse osmosis for employee water supply, versus bottled water service.
14. Rain sensors on landscape irrigation systems that shut off automatically when it rains.
15. Over 75% of hotel lighting uses energy efficient fluorescent bulbs
16. Water dispensing items are rated as conservation devices, such as: low flow toilets, low flow shower heads, low flow faucets

17. We buy office and guest amenity products that contain recycled material
18. We buy organic, fair trade, cruelty-free guest amenity products whenever possible such as bedding, hair and body care products, coffee and tea, etc
19. We use recycled paper products (with high post-consumer recycled content) that are either unbleached or bleached using a chlorine-free process
20. We use nontoxic or least toxic cleaners, sanitizers, paints, pesticides, etc. throughout the hotel. We make sure all chemicals are stored safely in a well-ventilated area
21. We have purchased "Energy Star" appliances when replacing old washing machines with both water and energy conserving models
22. We monitor energy and water use and make repairs or replace equipment when a problem is indicated
23. We are looking into printing with soy-based inks

Marinas

- 1 We are a certified Clean Marina.
- 2 We promote the use of non-toxic bottom paint on our tenant boats and applicants for slips
- 3 Recycling program for bottles, cans, paper, batteries, etc.
- 4 We emphasize and educate the tenants on the use of Best Management Practices
- 5 Any storm drains which empty into the bay are marked with a decal which alerts the public about protecting our waterways and the environment from pollution
- 6 We distribute educational materials to tenants about ways to protect the environment and how they contribute to the impact on the waterways.
- 7 We use our skiff to clean the water around the marina of trash and debris several times a week.
- 8 We also maintain our docks free of trash and items which could make their way into the water.
